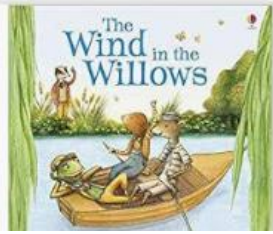


English

This term we are reading the book 'The Wind in the Willows' and writing diary entries from Mole's exciting adventures. Our focus is to investigate informal writing.



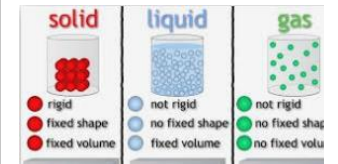
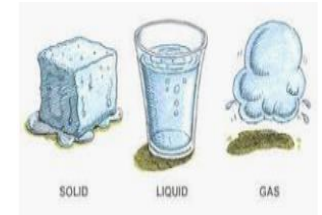
We will also be learning about the Stone Age period and writing instructions on how to light a fire.
