Why is London the capital city and not the Isle of Struay?

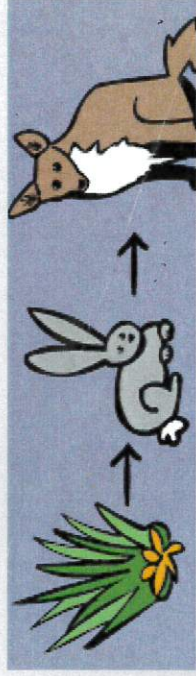
Design and Technology

As designers and technologists we shall be making our own London bus

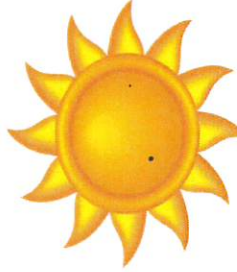


Time to think like a scientist
