Class arrangements for September 2018

From September, there will be some changes to the staffing and class arrangements:

Mrs Patchett is retiring, after nearly 29 years of service to the school. Mrs Parsons has been appointed as the Office Manager.

Mrs Collier is leaving us to start a new adventure teaching in Italy. We have appointed Mrs Smith as her replacement.

As the school goes from strength to strength and numbers on roll increase, we have attracted extra funding. This has allowed us to appoint an extra teacher – Mrs Oliviera – for part of the week to ensure reading, writing and maths skills are taught in smaller class sizes.

We are exceptionally lucky to have very capable and experienced support staff. This year, we will use the Apprenticeship Levy to provide training for 2 support staff to access higher level training.

The times of the teaching day have been altered slightly to be much more effective:

The morning session will run from 8.50 am to 12.15pm with a 15 minute break.

The afternoon session will run from 1.15pm to 3.30pm with a 10 minute break.

FS1 sessions remain unchanged (9.00am – 12.00pm, 12.30pm – 3.30pm)

Junior building: **Class 3* (Y3 and &Y4)**

Mrs Oliviera (class teacher) Mrs Wilson (Support Staff)

Class 4* (Y5 and &Y6)

Mrs Thompson & Mrs Smith (class teachers) Mrs Jones & Mrs Maston (Support Staff)

*In the afternoon sessions, class 3 and class 4 will be combined together within the junior classrooms.

The class will be teacher led and supported with a minimum of 2 support staff.

These sessions will be a carousel of activities eg topic, science, computing, art and technology allowing us to fully embed our aim of 'learning by doing'.
