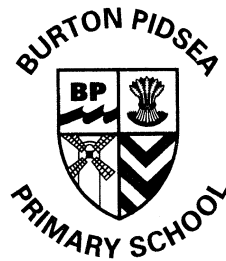

Please bring along a reasonably sized, smooth pebble that we can decorate.

Rev. S. Walker will be conducting the school assembly at 3pm, based on the theme of remembrance. You are more than welcome to stay and take part.

Thursday 8th November

The children may come to school **dressed as evacuees** to help bring their learning and understanding of the impact of war to life. In WWI, teachers and children were evacuated out of London, primarily for the safety of the children.
