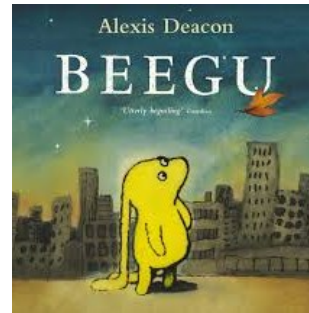


Science —

Observational drawings of the locality

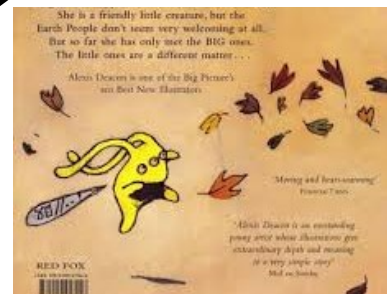

Maths —

- Tell the time to the hour, half hour, quarter past, quarter to and 5 minute intervals.
- Know the number of minutes in an hour and order the days of the week
- Interpret and construct simple tally, pictograms and bar charts (Year 2)
- Count to 40 forwards and backwards, beginning with any number (Year 1)
- Recognise and know the value of different coins and notes
