### World Book Day

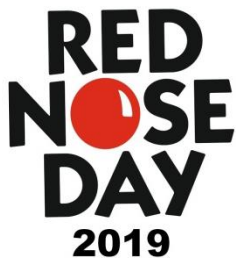


We will be celebrating world book day on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March. If they wish, your child may come to school dressed as a **character from a book**.

### Red Nose day



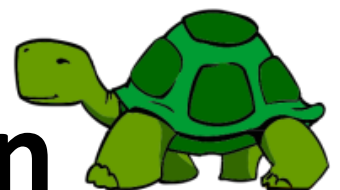
