Attendance & time keeping

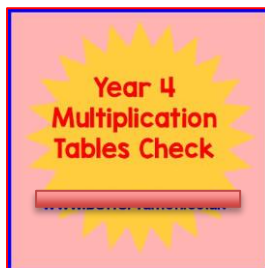
Following recent monitoring of our registers, we have noticed some children's attendance has fallen below our school target of 95%. Whilst I accept that children are ill and are requested to stay away from school until they are no longer infectious, there are some startling facts about poor attendance.

- For every day of school missed by a pupil it will reduce their attendance by 0.5%.
- Ten whole days of school has been missed if your child has 95% attendance.
- Twenty whole days of school has been missed if a pupil's attendance is 90%.
- By the time a pupil is persistently absent (less than 85% attendance) they have missed nearly 6 weeks (half a term) of schooling.

Lateness also has a negative impact. Being late can disrupt lessons, affect achievement and embarrass or upset your child. The start of the school day is an important time for children to develop their social skills with their peers, as well as preparing them for their learning.

Being late adds up to loss of learning:

- 5 minutes late every day adds up to 3 days lost each year
- 10 minutes late every day adds up to 6 days lost each year
- 15 minutes late every day adds up to 10 days lost each year
- 20 minutes late every day adds up to 13 days lost each year
- 30 minutes late every day adds up to 19 days lost each year



Next Summer (2020), there will be a statutory multiplication tables check for all Year 4 children. Our current Y3 children will be the first cohort to take this test, which will be an online programme.

Our current Y3s & Y4s will have an opportunity to take part in a trial of this test. **The results will not be recorded or published.** This will happen in the final part of the Summer term.
